Following the legacy of the age old school, Morning Star St. Anselm School also has chosen this great saint as the school Patron, who was not only an intellectual saint of his time but also the most holy, humble and simple person.

St. Anselm was born in Aosta in the Italian Alps. His mother was a good and a pious woman. From her he learnt his first lessons in love and charity. At a young age he decided to become a monk and dedicate his life to God. Soon his superiors discovered his intellectual abilities and he was made an Abbot against his will. His fame having spread far and wide, the king of England invited him to be his counselor. Having served the king, Anselm intended to return to his country but the

Anselm refused the honour but he was literally forced to take up the job on popular demand and was consecrated Archbishop of Canterbury on 4th December, 1093. But St. Anselm refused to give into the evil designs of the king and for this he suffered a great deal. He always did what was right and what was useful to other people. He was the greatest intellectual of his times. Besides, he is hailed as the father of the Scholastic Theology.

His Chief achievement in Philosophy was the Ontological Argument for the existence of God put forth in his famous thesis 'Prosologium' in which he affirmed "God is that than which nothing greater can be thought". We hope that under the patronage of this great Saint, the students imbibe his intellectual zeal for truth and his moral teachings to make them proficient in wisdom and develop a sound character.

## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Morning Star St. Anselm's School, Madrampura, is one of the branches of St. Anselm's group of Schools present in and outside Jaipur. It is one of the many Christian Minority Institutions run by the Gyan Deep Education Society. It is a coeducational institution and imparts education through English Medium. It is affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi. The school provides a sound education system designed to make its students fit for the world of tomorrow.

We believe in creating an environment that nurtures not just academic success but also focusses on personal development. The aim of the school is to give boys and girls a sound intellectual, physical and moral education, so that they turn out to be good and upright citizens. ## **ACADEMICS**

The scholastic year begins from April to March and is divided into two Terms: Semester-I & Semester-II. Reports of conduct, application and progress are issued at the end of each examination and are sent to the parents/guardians. Regular Parent-Teacher meetings are held throughout the year. Students are expected to speak only in English in the school premises. Parents or guardians are allowed to meet the teachers only on Saturdays, immediately after the school gets over with the prior sanction from the principal to discuss the matters regarding the progress of their children, questions and clarifications pertaining to academic performance and activities. The principal has the right to take disciplinary action against any student as he may deem necessary.



## **ADMISSION**

The admission process is designed to be comprehensive, transparent, and accessible. Here are some key features that are to be followed:

- Admission Criteria: We welcome students from diverse backgrounds and abilities. Admission is open to all students meeting age-appropriate criteria for each grade level.
- **Application Process:** To initiate the admission process, parents/guardians are required to fill the application form available at the school administrative office.
- **Required Documentation:** Please submit the following documents along with the application form:
  - The original and an attested Photostat copy of Birth Certificate from the Municipal Council.
  - Photocopy of Aadhar Card of the parent and the student.
  - Passport size photographs of the child.
  - Previous school records and academic transcripts (if applicable).
- Entrance Assessment: As part of our commitment to ensure a suitable academic environment for each student, an entrance assessment will be conducted. The assessment is designed to gauge the student's proficiency and determine the appropriate grade level.
- Admission Decision: Once the application process is complete, including assessments and interviews, the parents/guardians will be notified of the admission decision in a timely manner.
- After the admission, no change in the name of the student and the parents or other details will be entertained.

### **WITHDRAWAL**

- A calendar month's notice is to be given before the withdrawal of a student or else the fee will be charged. Such notice should be given in writing by the person responsible for the student and not by the student him/herself.
- No school leaving certificate is given until all the dues have been paid in full.
- A pupil failing twice in the same class must discontinue his/her studies in the school.

## **TRANSPORT**

Our transportation services are designed to provide a secure and comfortable journey to and from school. Here are the key details:

- We have meticulously planned bus routes that covers various neighbourhoods to ensure accessibility for all our students.
- School buses are operated by experienced and trained drivers who prioritize safety and adhere to traffic regulations.

## **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

## **Dress Code Compliance:**

- > Students are expected to wear the complete and correct uniform at all times during school hours, including any school-related events or excursions. The school enforces a strict dress code policy to maintain a uniform and respectful appearance.
- Except on Sundays and holidays mentioned in the school calendar, students must report to school in neat and clean school uniform.
- Boys / Girls who come to school without a proper uniform must bring a note of excuse from their parents or guardians, else they will be sent home and the school disclaims any responsibility.

## PARENTAL CO-OPERATION

- ❖ Parents must recognize that they are primarily and principally responsible for the education of their children. It is their duty to create a family atmosphere inspired by love and devotion to God and their fellowmen.
- ❖ Parents are requested to go through the school rules carefully and abide by them faithfully.
- ❖ Parents are expected to cooperate with the school by enforcing regularity and discipline in their children and by taking keen interest in their child's progress.
- ❖ Parents must check the student's diary and note the teacher/principal's remark, if any on a regular basis.
- The progress report or the examination results should be seen by the parents. Remedial measures should promptly be taken. If there are any complaints, they may be addressed to the principal or the school office directly.
- Every student ought to devote sufficient time for self-study daily.
- ❖ Parents/guardians must ensure that their ward completes the home-works and prepares the lessons daily. They also must insist on punctuality and regularity in attending the classes.
- Attendance at all school functions by the parents is also very important.



## **ATTENDANCE / LEAVE**

- 1. No leave of absence is granted except on a written application from parent or guardian. The leave must be entered on the 'Leave Record' page of the diary and must be duly signed by the Principal before it is taken. A student taking leave without permission of the Principal may be dismissed from the school forthwith.
- 2. A student who has been absent due to sickness or any other reason, returns to school, he/she must bring an written application and 'Attendance Leave Record' page of the diary duly signed by the parent or guardian.
- 3. Students not returning punctually to school after the holidays are liable to have their names struck off.
- 4. No boy/girl who has been absent from school, or who misses the first period of the first or second session will be admitted to class unless he/she brings a written excuse from home.
- 5. No student is allowed to leave the school premises during the school hours without a written application from a parent/guardian.



## **RULES FOR FEES**

- 1. School fees are taken quarterly in April, July, October and January.
- 2. The fees should be paid by the 10th of every concerned quarterly months.
- 3. All dues should be cleared before a student is admitted to the Quarterly, Half Yearly and Final Examination.
- 4. Pupils will not be allowed to sit for the examinations unless all dues are paid up to date.
- 5. Fees are to be paid in Cash / Cheque at the Bank given in the fee booklet or any other online mode.
- 6. Parents are required to check that the Bank returns them the parents' copy of the receipt duly signed and stamped.
- 7. Fees once paid will not be refunded.
